

THE TAXATION OF IPSWICH FOR THE
WELSH WAR IN 1282.

The war which involved the taxation here recorded was begun in March, 1282, by an attack on the English garrisons, under David, the brother of Llewellyn Prince of Wales, in which Robert de Clifford was captured and carried off, and the castles of Flint and Rhuddlan besieged by the Welsh.

King Edward at once collected his forces, and was able to begin his military operations in Wales in June, but the problem of financing his expedition was no easy one.

The Merchants of Lucca seem to have advanced money for the immediate necessities of the war, and in order to repay these loans the King, in the first place, dispatched *John de Kirkeby, Archdeacon of Coventry, in June on a mission to all the counties of England, "to declare certain important and arduous affairs," which, in other words, meant to negotiate a loan, the King undertaking to repay the same within a year.

Kirkeby seems to have been successful in his negotia-

tions, and the amounts which he obtained from the various places he visited will be found in the Lord Treasurer's Remembrancer's Enrolled Accounts in the Record Office.*

The account shows that the money thus raised was paid over to Bonruncini and other merchants of Lucca.

The following particulars, taken from the Enrolled Account, giving the amounts raised by Kirkeby in London and various East Anglian towns may be of interest,† as suggesting a comparison in wealth.

From the foregoing remarks it will be seen that the first document which I print here contains the names of such inhabitants of Ipswich as contributed to the loan of £100 raised by John de Kirkeby in 1282, and the amounts that they each paid.

The King's next step towards raising money was to summon a Parliament, the writ for which was dated at Rhuddlan, 24 Nov., 1282,‡ "ad audiendum et faciendum ea que sibi ex parte nostrâ faciemus ostendi," which was to meet at Northampton on 20 Jan., 1283 (N.S.), composed of four Knights from each shire, and two members from each city, borough or market town. At this Parliament the Subsidy of one-thirtieth was granted.

Though the Act itself does not appear to be extant, the important part of it has been luckily entered by a contemporary scribe in one of the Bury Abbey Registers,§

and the following quotations therefrom will explain its scope and limit :—

“Pur ceo ke les prodes hummes de ceo Realme unt franchement
 “grantee de eyder le Roy per la resun de sa geres de Wales Ceo est a
 “saver del trentyme de leurs beyns moebles ke il unt ou aveynt as
 “utaves de seynt yllere for pris tresor chivauchure liz Robes veselle
 “ustiz owes chapuns gelines payn vyn cerveyse citre e tute manere de
 “viandes prestes e pruvues as prudes hommes del Reaume ke ne sunt
 “burgeys ne marchauntz mez tuz les bens et les moebles de marchauns
 “et de burgeys seyent taxez et prisez sicut autre feez soleyent Kaunt
 “ayde fu grante as auncestres le rey.”

The limit of taxation is also fixed thus :—

“Ne nule ren ne seyt taxe ne levee de homme ke ne eyt bens a la
 “muntane de deý marc.”

There is also a clause stating that allowances would be made in collecting the thirtieth, for such sums as had been paid to Sir John de Kirkeby.

The Collectors of the tax were appointed in Feb. 1283 (N.S.),* and those selected for the county of Suffolk were John de Metingham, Will. de Pakenham, Simón de Daggworth, clerk, and Will. de Royngs, the Sheriff, who seem to have done their work carefully and methodically, which makes it more to be regretted that so few of the records of it are still extant. For Suffolk there are only now to be found the returns for the Hundred of Blackbourn, on 70 skins, and that for Ipswich which forms the second document printed here.

From the quotations given above, it appears that the method of assessment in Ipswich would be the same as had been in use for former subsidies. In the country districts, as shewn by the returns of Blackbourn, the assessment was made almost exclusively on agricultural produce and stock, which is given in some cases under as many as twenty different heads. It also appears that the King's promise to repay the loans granted to John de Kirkeby resolved itself into a remission of fresh taxation.

The amounts collected for this tax of one-thirtieth are also given in the Enrolled Account † under the several

counties, but the amounts paid by the different towns are not specified. From this account I give the following extracts :—

The original documents from which the following lists are printed are to be found in the Record Office under the Reference—Lay Subsidies Suffolk $\frac{2}{42}$ and $\frac{2}{43}$

No. $\frac{2}{42}$ contains first the list of those who lent £100, written on one long strip of parchment, about $20\frac{1}{4}$ in. by $3\frac{1}{2}$ in., and is in good condition and legible throughout. Then follows, sewn to it, the Tax Roll for one-thirtieth for Ipswich, which consists of five complete skins in good state and legible, measuring about $23\frac{1}{2}$ in. by 9 in. No. $\frac{2}{43}$ consists of only one skin, which was originally sewn on to the last-mentioned roll, as the holes for the thread exactly correspond, and the writing is the same; this skin, however, is considerably damaged, and partly gone on the right side, and has lately been mended.

In transcribing the documents I have substituted Arabic numerals for the Roman, for convenience sake.
