

IN MEMORIAM.

THE LATE EARL OF IVEAGH, K.P.

On the 7th October, 1927, Lord Iveagh passed to his rest, after a short illness. He had been a member of the Suffolk Institute of Archaeology for over twenty years. His generous and wise munificence in England and Ireland in the cause of education, the better housing of the poor and medical research will be long remembered. His bequest to the nation of his house at Ken Wood and his magnificent collection of pictures is also well known.

His large estate in Suffolk, comprising the parishes of Elveden, Eriswell and Icklingham is considered a model one from an agricultural and sporting point of view. The hall at Elveden was partly rebuilt and restored by him in the early part of this century, and the celebrated Marble Hall, the details of which were modelled from examples of ancient Indian art, was completed in 1903.

In 1901 under the guidance of the Society for the Protection of Ancient Buildings, Lord Iveagh re-roofed and restored the church of All Saint's, Icklingham, which has many treasures of antiquarian interest.

He also restored and re-roofed the old church of St. Andrew at Elveden and built on a nave, chancel and organ chamber; using the old church as the South Aisle and a private chapel; this was consecrated in October, 1906, by Bishop Chase of Ely and dedicated to St. Andrew and St. Patrick; W. D. Caroe, F.S.A., F.R.I.A., was the architect. Later the tall campanile with peal of ten bells, and the cloisters were added in memory of Lady Iveagh.

The War Memorial to the men of Elveden, Eriswell and Icklingham standing at the junction of the three parishes; was erected largely through his generosity; it is a Corinthian column about 120-ft. high on a tall base, surmounted by an urn; it is visible for many miles.

An Agricultural Institute at Chadacre Hall, for the training of farmers' sons and others was founded and endowed by him. As recently as the 26th August, 1927, Lord Iveagh entertained the members of the Institute to tea; when they visited Icklingham.

His body was laid to rest in the family vault at Elveden. To quote the "Diocesan Magazine," "A great Christian gentleman has passed to his rest, and the diocese, county and England are the poorer by his death."
