### *Blyford All Saints*

I apologise for my mistake on the second page (p. 348) of 'Flushwork Addenda' in *PSIAH* XLII Part 3 (2011). Butley church is dedicated to St John Baptist, not St Mary, and has a brick south porch with stone quoins but no flint.

The north porch at Blyford All Saints strongly resembles the south porch at Theberton and the device repeated in the lowest frieze above the plinth at both churches and at St Mary Quay, Ipswich is the comparison I was wishing to make. The device could be a simplified version of Aldryche [All](#) device. The Theberton porch is illustrated in *Decoding Flint Flushwork* at page 79.
